CÉCILE MCLORIN SALVANT (USA)

A once-in-a-generation talent, Cécile McLorin Salvant comes to Australia in November, and will perform in Perth for one night only as a headline act of this year's Perth International Jazz Festival.

Since winning the Thelonious Monk vocal competition in 2010 at aged 21, McLorin Salvant has continued to accumulate global accolades for her recordings and performances. Six albums display her unique musicianship, from her debut *WomanChild* in 2013 through to this year's multilingual release *Mélusine*.

She has won three consecutive Grammy Awards for Best Jazz Vocal Album: *For One To Love* (2015), *Dreams and Daggers* (2017), and *The Window* (2018), while her 2022 album *Ghost Song* has been nominated for two Grammys.

Her innate storytelling ability weaves together a range of musical styles including jazz, vaudeville, blues, theatre and folk music.

This twin set of three-piece bands features Switzerland-based MaxMantis and the Josh Meader Trio from Sydney.

Think Marvel meets DC meets jazz and you have MaxMantis. Returning to the PIJF is this formidable trio made up of Lukas Gernet (JeffMantis) on piano, Rafael Jerien (RexMantis) on bass, and Samuel Büttiker (BobMantis) on drums. Tonight, these three accomplished musicians will tell the ongoing story of their alternate superhero lives through musical themes, jingles, free improvisation and chaos. Here, stylistic and musical boundaries do not exist - into the infinite abyss and beyond! Maximum Mantis!

The Josh Meader Trio is an instrumental cross-genre powerhouse led by guitarist Josh Meader, second-place finalist in this year's National Jazz Awards, and featuring previous NJA winners Alex Hirlian (drums) and Matt Thomson (keys). Blending and blurring a multitude of genres including contemporary music, modern jazz, funk, hip-hop and rock, Josh Meader Trio presents an undeniably unique listening experience.

Barnett moved to Cologne in 2014, where she soon formed this quartet. They have released three albums together (Hype, Bad Lover and Alive *at Loft*) and have toured throughout Europe and Australia.

HELEN SVOBODA SOLO (VIC)

Helen Svoboda is a double bassist, vocalist and composer. In the words of the ABC Music Show's Andrew Ford, she is "a musician who absolutely defies categorisation". Her work explores the melodic potential of the contemporary double bass, intricately weaving extended techniques and overtones with vocal tessitura to explore themes of sonic unity amidst abstract songwriting.

GHOSTS BETWEEN STREAMS | DELAY 45 (NSW)

Ghosts Between Streams is an interdisciplinary work by 2022 Freedman Fellow, composer and trumpeter Tom Avgenicos. It blends chamber music, contemporary jazz and electronics to explore the power struggle between nature and urbanisation. With an overarching environmental concern, the work captures the notion of solastalgia – the sadness felt at the loss or change of a beloved place in nature. This will be performed by Avgenicos' long-standing quartet, Delay 45.

JO LAWRY ACROBATS TRIO (NSW/VIC/WA)

Jo Lawry, has been described by The New York Times as a "singer of dazzling self-possession".

Lawry has released four albums since 2008, after leaving Adelaide for New York, where she lived for 17 years. She has recorded and toured with Sting since 2009 and appeared in the 2013 documentary *20 Feet from Stardom*.

Her latest release, Acrobats, has been described by The Sydney Morning Herald as "a gem tossed high in the air, flashing and sparkling – and somehow never falling".

Jo Lawry's debut album, *I Want to Be Happy*, was named one of the "Best CDs of the Decade" by Downbeat Magazine, but she has become known beyond jazz circles for her work with Sting, Paul Simon and Peter Gabriel.

MATTHEW SHEENS (USA) WRITTEN IN THE DARK

Matthew Sheens is a genre-bending jazz pianist and composer. He is listed as one of Fred Hersch's "pianists you should know" and described in *The Australian* as "an outstanding pianist, stoked full of creative ideas and limitless technique... totally innovative and luminous".

Written in the Dark is a through-composed piece written while Sheens was convalescing after a bike crash that left him with a broken leg and hand.

Comprised of 10 sections, this piece explores many different musical terrains, while sustaining compositional ideas throughout. While the work can be described as a technically demanding weird dream, there is still huge scope for improvisation by the entire quartet.

Grammy-nominated, New York-based multiinstrumentalist Nate Wood called this project fOUR "because it's me with four limbs playing four instruments at once".

A truly ambitious take on going solo, Wood plays everything - analogue synths, drums, bass, guitar as well as vocals - at the same time.

fOUR's sound veers from complex, space-y prog rock to electronic-tinged instrumentals.

"Wood's brain splits attention between four synthesisers, an electric bass and a drum kit, all while singing about futurism. Wood plays all of

fOUR's tunes in one take. No backing tracks. No overdubs.... You're hearing (and seeing) a mastermind songwriter and mad scientist at work." NPR Music

Trio Grande is bigger than the average trio. It might look like there's no bass player, but in fact there are three. Nate Wood is perhaps the only person in the world able to play at a dazzling level on both drums and bass at the same time

Saxophonist Will Vinson doubles on keyboards and guitarist Gilad Hekselman is renowned for his ability to weave contrapuntal lines across the range of his instrument (and beyond). Together, the three deliver a sound as big and broad as a group twice its size.
